Places on Deer Isle open for Public Use

IHT’s Conserved Lands on Deer Isle



- Bowcat Point** – On Little Deer Isle side of Causeway
- Causeway Beach** – Along Causeway between Little Deer Isle -Deer Isle
- Lily Pond Beach** – Park at Deer Run and walk in
- Reach Beach off Gray’s Cove** – At far East end of Reach Road
- Settlement Quarry** – About ½ mile down Oceanville Road
(not on Settlement Rd)
- Scotts Landing** - North of and across from Causeway Beach
- Shore Acres** – Off Greenlaw District Road (between Sunshine Rd
& Reach Rd)
- Tennis Preserve** –At end of Tennis Road off Sunshine Road, BPL land
co-managed by IHT

Land owned by The Nature Conservancy maintained by IHT




- Barred Island Preserve** - Near end of Goose Cove Road
- Crocket Cove Preserve** - Off Whitman Road at Burnt Cove

IHT’s Conserved off-shore Islands open for day use



- Bradbury Island** – Large Island in Penobscot Bay, West of Deer Isle
- Carney Island** – SW of Causeway Beach, IHT owns North half of Island
Eagle nesting site, Island closed March -July
- Mark Island** (landing not recommended) – SW of Crotch Island
- Millet Island** – In Archipelago, NE of Spruce Island
- Polypod Island** – In Deer Isle’s Southeast Harbor
- Round Island** – In Archipelago, between McGlathery & Wreck
- Sheep Island** – West of Little Deer Isle near Blastow Cove

Wreck Island – In Archipelago, West of McGlathery

Bureau of Public Lands (BPL) Islands open to the Public 

Apple Island – Located in Fish Creek NW of Campbell Island

Harbor Island – In Archipelago, North of Merchant's Island


Hell's Half Acre – In Archipelago, Cradled between Camp,
Bold & Devil Islands

Little Sheep – Near Sheep Island (off of Oceanville)

Potato Island – NE of Stinson Neck (not the one near St. Helena)

Steve Island – In Archipelago, West of Wreck Island

Weir Island – Close to shore West of Moose Island

Bear Island – SE end of Eggemoggin Reach on the Deer Isle side

Bill's Island – In Archipelago, South of McGlathery

Eastern Mark Island – In Archipelago, SE of Oceanville's Sheep Island

Gooseberry Island – In Archipelago, small island SE of McGlathery

Green Island – In Archipelago, SE of Stonington

Pond – Eastern Penobscot Bay on the Western side of Little Deer Isle

Nathan Island – In Archipelago, between Merchant and Isle Au Haut

Saddleback Island – In Archipelago, South of Eastern Mark Island

Sand Island – In Archipelago, South of Crotch Island

The Fort – Off of Fifield Pt., South of Burnt Cove

 **McGlathery Island** – In Archipelago, SW of Stonington

Russ – In Archipelago, SW of Stonington, Owned by Chewonki Foundation

Campbell – East of Deer Isle, between Oak Point and Greenlaw Neck
Eagle nesting site, Island closed March -July
